6 **ARTICLE II – MISSION AND OBJECTIVES** *(old material crossed out, new material capitalized)*

7 **Section 2.** The objectives of the College are:

8 5. To encourage and improve the educational opportunities for the training of osteopathic family
9 physicians in all branches of osteopathic medicine and surgery, including the osteopathic family practice
10 MEDICINE training programs;

12 **ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS**

13 The elected officers of this College shall be the President, President-Elect, the Past Presidents for the
14 preceding two years, Vice President, AND Secretary/Treasurer, ~~six (6) Governors-at-large, and Speaker~~

17 **ARTICLE VII - BOARD OF GOVERNORS**

18 **Section 1.** The Board of Governors shall be composed of the President, President-Elect, the Past
19 Presidents for the preceding two years, Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer, six (6) Governors-at-large,
20 one osteopathic family medicine Resident GOVERNOR, and one osteopathic medical Student
21 GOVERNOR, and the Speaker of the Congress of Delegates, all to be selected as provided in the Bylaws.
22 The Speaker has voice but no vote.
