WHEREAS, the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) has recommended curriculum guidelines for family medicine residents defining a training strategy to address the needs of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender patient population, and

WHEREAS, the ACOFP adopted a non-discrimination policy regarding lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender patients, now; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) write a letter to the Association of Family Medicine Residency Directors (AFMRD) requesting that it encourage family medicine residency programs and program directors to advocate for a lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender non-discrimination policy within resident contracts at their respective institutions.
