RESOLUTION NO. 28

- 1 WHEREAS, the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) encourages work force  
2 diversity in family medicine training, including residencies, and medical schools, and  
3  
4 WHEREAS, the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) has recommended  
5 curriculum guidelines for family medicine residents defining a training strategy to  
6 address the needs of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender patient population, and  
7  
8 WHEREAS, the ACOFP adopted a non-discrimination policy regarding lesbian, gay, bisexual,  
9 and transgender patients, now; therefore be it  
10  
11 RESOLVED, that the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (ACOFP) write a letter  
12 to the Association of Family Medicine Residency Directors (AFMRD) requesting that it  
13 encourage family medicine residency programs and program directors to advocate for a  
14 lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender non-discrimination policy within resident contracts  
15 at their respective institutions.
