RESOLUTION NO. 7

14 **ARTICLE V - CONGRESS OF DELEGATES**

16 **Section 1.** Composition

18 D. One voting delegate and one alternate delegate shall represent the resident members
19 of the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians. The delegates shall be
20 appointed annually by the Resident Council of the ACOFP. The Resident Council shall
21 certify its delegate and alternate delegate to the ACOFP Executive Director in writing
22 at least 30 days prior to the first day of the annual meeting of the Congress of
23 Delegates.
