15 **Section 1. Composition**

17 C. One voting delegate and one alternate delegate shall represent the student association of  
18 the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (Student Association of the  
19 ACOFP). The delegates shall be appointed annually by the National Student Executive  
20 Board. The National Student Executive Board shall certify its delegate and alternate  
21 delegate to the ACOFP Executive Director in writing at least 30 days prior to the first day  
22 of the annual meeting of the Congress of Delegates.
